Fatal Crash in Robbinsville Township Under Investigation

The Robbinsville Township Police Department and the Mercer County Prosecutor's Office Serious Collision Response Team are investigating a multi-vehicle accident that occurred Monday evening, resulting in one fatality and multiple people injured.

Preliminary investigation indicates that around 6:30 p.m., a white GMC Savana work van traveling south on Route 130 caused a Pontiac Trans Am to cross the median in the area of Woodside Road, where it collided with vehicles traveling in the opposite direction. The white van proceeded to flee the scene and was located this morning in Langhorne, Pennsylvania. The driver of the van has not been located at this time.

The driver of the Trans Am, identified as Vincent Zitani, 23, of Yardville, NJ, was pronounced dead at the scene. The driver of a Hyundai Elantra, an adult male, remains hospitalized. He was the only occupant. The fourth vehicle involved, a Toyota Highlander, was occupied by six individuals - a set of parents, grandparents, a teenage daughter and a family friend. Most of those individuals remain hospitalized. The teenage girl was airlifted to RWJ University Hospital New Brunswick where she is currently in stable condition.
